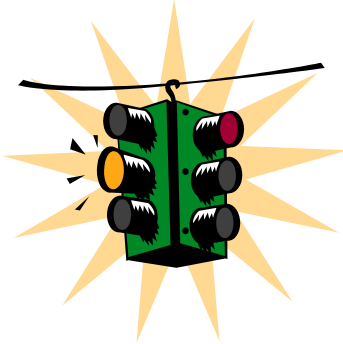

NEW AT THE LIBRARY!!

We now have a traffic light that tells students if they are getting too loud!

Red light – Everyone stops talking.

Yellow light – Caution: It is getting too loud.

Green light – Great job! Keep up the good work!

Library Rules

Students will be on their very best behavior.

Students will use their “ Inside Voice” when talking.

Students will walk quietly.

Students will keep their hands and feet to themselves.

Students will treat everyone with courtesy and respect.

Students will clean up their table at the end of their library time.

Students will remember to return their books to the librarian.

Students will remember to bring their library card to the library.

Students will need a library pass from your teacher to come to the library by himself or by herself. The library pass is good for one student at a time – no groups.

The teacher will always be told if you misbehave or break any of the library rules.

Your Library Card

Each student is given a library card. Students need to bring their library card with them to check out books, movies, and magazines. Students may not use a card that belongs to someone else.

Due Dates

Books, magazines and videos are due to be returned to the library 7 days from the day that you checked it out. Books that are checked out on Monday are due back the next Monday.

Renewing Books

Books may be renewed (checked out again) each week for an additional 7 days, up to 4 times, if you have no overdue books, movies or magazines. Magazines and videos may not be renewed.

Returning Books

Please return all books, movies and magazines that you have checked out to the librarian' s desk. Please do not put them on the shelf – they need to be checked in first.

Overdue Books

If you have any book, magazine or video that is overdue (late), you cannot check out anything else until everything has been returned to the librarian and the overdue fine has been paid.

Library Fines

The library fine is 5¢ each day for each book, magazine or video. No fines accumulate on the weekend or on school holidays.

Replacement Library Cards

Each student is required to have their own library card in order to check out books, magazines and videos. A replacement library card will only be issued if their card is lost, not if it was only left at home. The cost of a replacement library card is \$2.

Accelerated Reading Books

All of the Accelerated Reading Books, fiction and nonfiction, are now labeled if the school has the test that goes with the book. For fiction books, there is a read accelerated reader label plus the reading level sticker (Kindergarten to 6th). For nonfiction books, including literature, there is a color-coded reading level sticker plus the Dewey Decimal label. Each reading level, from 3rd grade up to 12th grade, has a different color. Your teacher has a current list of books by grade level; the library has a master list of the books and the tests, that can be searched by title, author or grade level.
