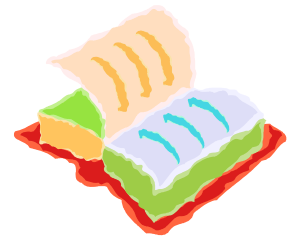

Writing Rules:

- Each student should have a different topic; NO STUDENT CAN HAVE THE SAME TOPIC FOR HIS OR HER PAPER.
- Your paper must have a heading.
- If hand-written the lines must be skipped. If typed: 12size and Times New Roman font.
- Do not forget to indent each paragraph.
- Prepositions and articles should be in small letters.
- Include one page of pictures and/or maps with your paper.
- Must include:
 - Family information
 - Major events of life
 - Lifetime accomplishments; Effects/impact on society, historical significance (Why is this person famous? What did this person do to become famous? How has this person made an impact on others' lives?)

Due date for written paper: May 03, 2010

Distribution of Points:

- Appearance (cover page, report cover)..... 10 points
- Significance of your topic 10 points
- Introduction/conclusion in paper..... 10 points

- Originality and handwriting..... 10 points
- Grammar, Punctuation, indented paragraphs and Spelling. 20 points
- Pictures/Maps (Any Visual)..... 10 points
- Presentation*..... 30 points

*STUDENTS CAN ONLY USE THE PICTURES AND/OR MAPS DURING THE PRESENTATION. NO READING FROM THEIR PAPERS IS ALLOWED. INSTEAD, THEY MAY USE INDEX CARDS FOR THEIR PRESENTATION.

Presentation

Presentation Date: Tuesday and Wednesday May 03 and 04

Presentation will be in the assembly.

1. *You have to tell all about the person you choose in such a way as if you are that person.*
2. *Capture your reader's attention through comedy, questioning, or other means.*
3. *Title may be 'Who Am I?' or create your own title but do not give the audience any clues about the name.*
4. *Include the following details on your presentation:*
 - *Family*
 - *Personality; Likes and Dislikes*
 - *Goals and Aspirations; Significance / contribution*
 - *Pictures/Maps*
5. *At the end of the presentation ask the question to the audience loudly "Who Am I? Or ask or say in such a way so that you do not disclose his name. " Look at everyone as if you are waiting for their reply.*
6. *Say the name two times loudly and read or say their accomplishments in short (3/4 bullet points).*
7. *Your presentation should not exceed more than three minutes.*
8. *Please read the presentation rubric carefully to obtain a good grade.*
